1-8 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-9 AN ACT

1-10 relating to the change of the name of Texas A&M
1-11 University--Kingsville to Texas A&I University.

1-12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-13 SECTION 1. The heading to Subchapter D, Chapter 87,
1-14 Education Code, is amended to read as follows:

1-15 SUBCHAPTER D. TEXAS A&I UNIVERSITY
1-16 [~~A&M UNIVERSITY--KINGSVILLE~~]

1-17 SECTION 2. Section 87.301, Education Code, is amended to
1-18 read as follows:

1-19 Sec. 87.301. ESTABLISHMENT. (a) Texas A&I University [~~A&M~~
1-20 ~~University--Kingsville~~] is a coeducational institution of higher
1-21 education located in the city of Kingsville. The university is a
1-22 component institution of The Texas A&M University System and is
1-23 under the management and control of the board of regents of The
1-24 Texas A&M University System.

1-25 (b) The board has the same powers and duties concerning
1-26 Texas A&I University [~~A&M University--Kingsville~~] as are conferred
1-27 on it by statute concerning Texas A&M University.

1-28 SECTION 3. Subdivision (1), Section 51.502, Education Code,
1-29 is amended to read as follows:

1-30 (1) "Eligible institution" means the college,
1-31 department, or other unit of engineering at any of the following
1-32 institutions of higher education:

- 1-33 (A) The University of Texas at Austin;
- 1-34 (B) The University of Texas at Arlington;
- 1-35 (C) The University of Texas at El Paso;
- 1-36 (D) The University of Texas at San Antonio;
- 1-37 (E) The University of Texas of the Permian Basin;
- 1-38 (F) Texas A&M University;
- 1-39 (G) Prairie View A&M University;
- 1-40 (H) Texas Tech University;
- 1-41 (I) Lamar University;
- 1-42 (J) University of Houston; and
- 1-43 (K) Texas A&I University [~~A&M~~
1-44 ~~University--Kingsville~~].

1-45 SECTION 4. Subdivision (3), Section 61.003, Education Code,
1-46 is amended to read as follows:

1-47 (3) "General academic teaching institution" means The
1-48 University of Texas at Austin; The University of Texas at El Paso;
1-49 The University of Texas of the Permian Basin; The University of
1-50 Texas at Dallas; The University of Texas at San Antonio; Texas A&M
1-51 University, Main University; The University of Texas at Arlington;
1-52 Tarleton State University; Prairie View A&M University; Texas
1-53 Maritime Academy; Texas Tech University; University of North Texas;
1-54 Lamar University; Lamar State College--Orange; Lamar State
1-55 College--Port Arthur; Texas A&I University [~~A&M~~
1-56 ~~University--Kingsville~~]; Texas A&M University--Corpus Christi;
1-57 Texas Woman's University; Texas Southern University; Midwestern
1-58 State University; University of Houston; University of Texas--Pan
1-59 American; The University of Texas at Brownsville; Texas A&M
1-60 University--Commerce; Sam Houston State University; Texas State
1-61 University--San Marcos; West Texas A&M University; Stephen F.
1-62 Austin State University; Sul Ross State University; Angelo State
1-63 University; The University of Texas at Tyler; and any other

2-1 college, university, or institution so classified as provided in
2-2 this chapter or created and so classified, expressly or impliedly,
2-3 by law.

2-4 SECTION 5. Subsection (c), Section 85.70, Education Code,
2-5 is amended to read as follows:

2-6 (c) The board shall lease for oil, gas, sulphur, or other
2-7 mineral development, as prescribed by this subchapter, all or part
2-8 of the land under the exclusive control of the board owned by the
2-9 State of Texas and acquired for the use of Texas A&I University [~~A&M~~
2-10 ~~University--Kingsville~~] and its divisions. Any money received by
2-11 the board concerning such land under this subchapter shall be
2-12 deposited in the state treasury to the credit of a special fund to
2-13 be known as the Texas A&I University [~~A&M University--Kingsville~~]
2-14 special mineral fund, to be used exclusively for Texas A&I
2-15 University [~~A&M University--Kingsville~~] and its branches and
2-16 divisions. Money may not be expended from this fund except as
2-17 authorized by the general appropriations act.

2-18 SECTION 6. (a) A reference in law to Texas A&M
2-19 University--Kingsville means Texas A&I University.

2-20 (b) An appropriation for the use and benefit of Texas A&M
2-21 University--Kingsville is available for the use and benefit of
2-22 Texas A&I University.

2-23 SECTION 7. This Act does not make appropriation. A
2-24 provision in this Act that creates a new governmental program,
2-25 creates a new entitlement, or imposes a new duty on a governmental
2-26 entity is not mandatory during a fiscal period for which the
2-27 legislature has not made a specific appropriation to implement the
2-28 provision.

2-29 SECTION 8. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
