1-8 relating to the location at which a certification examination for
1-9 interpreters for the deaf or hard of hearing may be conducted.

1-10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-11 SECTION 1. Subsection (i), Section 81.007, Human Resources
1-12 Code, is amended to read as follows:

1-13 (i) The commission shall determine the frequency for
1-14 conducting the interpreter examinations. The commission shall
1-15 conduct the interpreter examinations:

1-16 (1) in a space ~~[Austin at the commission's office or in~~
1-17 ~~other space owned or leased by the state]~~ that can be obtained free
1-18 of charge; or

1-19 (2) at a facility selected in compliance with Section
1-20 2113.106, Government Code ~~[in other cities in this state in space~~
1-21 ~~that can be obtained free of charge].~~

1-22 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-25 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-26 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
