## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the dispensing of drugs by physicians. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 158.001(b), Occupations Code, is amended 5 to read as follows: 6 (b) A physician may dispense dangerous drugs and controlled substances to the physician's patients and charge the patients for 7 the drugs [This section does not permit a physician to operate a 8 9 retail pharmacy] without complying with Chapter 558. SECTION 2. Section 551.004(b), Occupations Code, is amended 10 11 to read as follows: 12 (b) This subtitle does not prevent a practitioner from: 13 (1) administering a drug to a patient of the 14 practitioner; or (2) supplying drugs to a patient as provided by 15 16 Section 158.001(b). SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 17 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 18 19 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 20 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 21 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
