- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 171, Local Government Code, is amended 6 by adding Section 171.011 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 171.011. POST-EMPLOYMENT ACTIVITIES (a) In a county
- 8 with a population of 3.3 million or more, a former local public
- 9 official of the county, a precinct, a flood control district, or a
- 10 hospital district may not
- 11 (1) make any communication to or appearance before the
- 12 commissioners court or other governing body under which the
- 13 official served, or any other official thereof, with the intent to
- 14 <u>influence official action on behalf of another before the second</u>
- 15 anniversary of the date the former official terminated employment
- 16 or left office or

- 17 (2) represent any person or receive compensation for
- 18 services rendered on behalf of any person regarding a particular
- 19 matter in which the official personally participated or over which
- 20 official had responsibility during the period of the official's
- 21 public service.
- 22 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

- 1 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 2 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
