- 5 SECTION 1. Section 545.356(b-1), Transportation Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (b-1) Except as provided by Subsection (b-2), the governing
- 8 body of a municipality, for a highway or a part of a highway in an
- 9 urban district in the municipality that is not an officially
- 10 designated or marked highway or road of the state highway system and
- 11 $\underline{\text{that}}$ [$_{\boldsymbol{\tau}}$] is 35 feet or less in width, [$\underline{\text{and along which vehicular}}$
- 12 parking is not prohibited on one or both sides of the highway, and a may
- 13 declare a lower speed limit of not less than 25 miles per hour, if
- 14 the governing body determines that the prima facie speed limit on
- 15 the highway is unreasonable or unsafe.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
