5	SECTION 1. Subtitle A, Title 5, Special District Local Laws
6	Code, is amended by adding Chapter 5006 to read as follows:
7	CHAPTER 5006. MATAGORDA COUNTY NAVIGATION DISTRICT NO. 1
8	SUBCHAPTER A. GENERAL PROVISIONS
9	Sec. 5006.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:
10	(1) "Board" means the board of navigation and canal
11	commissioners of the district.
12	(2) "Commissioner" means a member of the board.
13	(3) "District" means the Matagorda County Navigation
14	District No. 1.

16	SUBCHAPTER B. DISTRICT ADMINISTRATION
17	Sec. 5006.051. BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS; TERM; ELECTION.
18	(a) The district is governed by a board consisting of five
19	commissioners elected at large.
20	(b) Commissioners serve staggered six-year terms, with the
21	terms of one or two commissioners expiring on November 30 of each
22	even-numbered year.
23	(c) An election shall be held in the district every two
24	years on the uniform election date in November to elect one or two

1 commissioners.

- 2 SECTION 2. (a) Notwithstanding Section 5006.051, Special
- 3 District Local Laws Code, as added by this Act, on the uniform
- 4 election date in November 2010, the board of navigation and canal
- 5 commissioners of the Matagorda County Navigation District No. 1
- 6 shall hold an election to elect:
- 7 (1) one commissioner to serve a term expiring
- 8 November 30, 2014; and
- 9 (2) two commissioners to serve terms expiring
- 10 November 30, 2016.
- 11 (b) On the uniform election date in November of each
- 12 even-numbered year after 2010, the board of navigation and canal
- 13 commissioners of the Matagorda County Navigation District No. 1
- 14 shall hold an election to elect the appropriate number of
- 15 commissioners to serve six-year terms.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 17 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 18 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 19 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 20 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
