## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to eligibility requirements to serve as a member of the
- 3 board of directors of the Bee Groundwater Conservation District.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subsection (a), Section 8804.052, Special
- 6 District Local Laws Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) A person must own land in the single-member district
- 8 from which the person is elected to serve as a director.
- 9 SECTION 2. Subsection (a), Section 8804.052, Special
- 10 District Local Laws Code, as amended by this Act, applies only to a
- 11 member of the board of directors of the Bee Groundwater
- 12 Conservation District who is elected to the board on or after the
- 13 effective date of this Act. A member who is elected to the board
- 14 before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in
- 15 effect on the date the member was elected, and the former law is
- 16 continued in effect for that purpose.
- 17 SECTION 3. (a) The legal notice of the intention to
- 18 introduce this Act, setting forth the general substance of this
- 19 Act, has been published as provided by law, and the notice and a
- 20 copy of this Act have been furnished to all persons, agencies,
- 21 officials, or entities to which they are required to be furnished
- 22 under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313,
- 23 Government Code.
- 24 (b) The governor, one of the required recipients, has

- 1 submitted the notice and Act to the Texas Commission on
- 2 Environmental Quality.
- 3 (c) The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed
- 4 its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor, the
- 5 lieutenant governor, and the speaker of the house of
- 6 representatives within the required time.
- 7 (d) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this
- 8 state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect
- 9 to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act are fulfilled
- 10 and accomplished.
- 11 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 12 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 13 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 14 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 15 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
