Subsection (a), Section 8804.052, Special6District Local Laws Code, is amended to read as follows:

7 (a) A person must own land in the <u>single-member</u> district
8 <u>from which the person is elected</u> to serve as a director.

SECTION 2. Subsection (a), Section 8804.052, 9 Special 10 District Local Laws Code, as amended by this Act, applies only to a member of the board of directors of the Bee Groundwater 11 12 Conservation District who is elected to the board on or after the 13 effective date of this Act. A member who is elected to the board before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in 14 15 effect on the date the member was elected, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. 16

The legal notice of the intention 17 SECTION 3. (a) to introduce this Act, setting forth the general substance of this 18 Act, has been published as provided by law, and the notice and a 19 copy of this Act have been furnished to all persons, agencies, 20 officials, or entities to which they are required to be furnished 21 under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313, 22 Government Code. 23

submitted the notice and Act to the Texas Commission on
 Environmental Quality.

The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed (c) 3 its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor, the 4 lieutenant governor, and the speaker of the house 5 of representatives within the required time. 6

7 (d) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this 8 state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect 9 to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act are fulfilled 10 and accomplished.

SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
