1-6 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to the governing body of the Agua Special Utility
1-9 District.

1-10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-11 SECTION 1. Section 7201.052, Special District Local Laws
1-12 Code, is amended by amending Subsection (j) and adding Subsection
1-13 (k-1) to read as follows:

1-14 (j) A director may not serve more than two consecutive
1-15 terms. An initial appointment under Section 7201.051 constitutes
1-16 one term.

1-17 (k-1) A person who was appointed as an initial director
1-18 under Section 7201.051 is eligible to serve as an elected director.

1-19 SECTION 2. (a) The legal notice of the intention to
1-20 introduce this Act, setting forth the general substance of this
1-21 Act, has been published as provided by law, and the notice and a
1-22 copy of this Act have been furnished to all persons, agencies,
1-23 officials, or entities to which they are required to be furnished
1-24 under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313,
1-25 Government Code.

1-26 (b) The governor, one of the required recipients, has
1-27 submitted the notice and Act to the Texas Commission on
1-28 Environmental Quality.

1-29 (c) The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed
1-30 its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor, the
1-31 lieutenant governor, and the speaker of the house of
1-32 representatives within the required time.

1-33 (d) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this
1-34 state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect
1-35 to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act are fulfilled
1-36 and accomplished.

1-37 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.

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
