## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to a bailiff for the 130th District Court.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Subsection (a), Section 53.002, Government Code,
5	is amended to read as follows:
6	(a) The judges of the 34th, 86th, <u>130th,</u> 142nd, 238th,
7	318th, 355th, and 385th district courts may each appoint a bailiff.
8	SECTION 2. Subsection (b), Section 53.004, Government Code,
9	is amended to read as follows:
10	(b) To be eligible to be appointed bailiff in the 30th,
11	78th, 86th, 89th, <u>130th,</u> or 341st district court, the County Court
12	of Harrison County, a court described in Section 53.002(c), a
13	district court in Taylor County, or a county court at law of Taylor
14	County, a person must be a resident of the county in which the
15	person serves the court and must be at least 21 years old.
16	SECTION 3. Subsection (a), Section 53.007, Government Code,
17	is amended to read as follows:
18	(a) This section applies to:
19	(1) the 22nd, 34th, 70th, 71st, 86th, 97th, <u>130th,</u>
20	142nd, 161st, 238th, 318th, 341st, 355th, and 385th district
21	courts;
22	(2) the County Court of Harrison County;
23	(3) the criminal district courts of Tarrant County;
24	(4) the district courts in Taylor County;

1 (5) the courts described in Section 53.002(c), (d),
2 (e), or (f);

(6) the county courts at law of Taylor County;

4 (7) the district courts in Tarrant County that give 5 preference to criminal cases; and

(8) the 115th District Court in Upshur County.

7 SECTION 4. Section 53.008, Government Code, is amended to 8 read as follows:

9 Sec. 53.008. OATH. The bailiffs of the 22nd, 34th, 70th, 86th, 97th, 130th, 142nd, 161st, 238th, 318th, 341st, 355th, and 10 385th district courts, the bailiffs of the courts described in 11 Section 53.002(c), (d), (e), or (f), the bailiffs and the grand jury  $% \left( \frac{1}{2} \right) = 0$ 12 13 bailiffs of the district courts in Tarrant County that give preference to criminal cases, the bailiffs and grand jury bailiffs 14 15 of the criminal district courts in Tarrant County, the bailiffs of 16 the district courts in Taylor County, and the bailiffs of the county courts at law of Taylor County shall each swear to the following 17 oath, to be administered by the judge: "I solemnly swear that I 18 will faithfully and impartially perform all duties as may be 19 required of me by law, so help me God." 20

21 SECTION 5. Section 53.009, Government Code, is amended by 22 adding Subsection (n) to read as follows:

23 (n) A bailiff appointed by the judge of the 130th District 24 Court is entitled to receive a salary set by the Commissioners Court 25 of Matagorda County in an amount that is not less than the salary of 26 a deputy sheriff regularly assigned to patrol duty in that county.

27 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
