1-8 relating to the composition and operation of the Hunt County
1-9 Juvenile Board.

1-10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-11 SECTION 1. Subsections (a), (b), and (d), Section 152.1221,
1-12 Human Resources Code, are amended to read as follows:

1-13 (a) The Hunt County Juvenile Board is composed of the county
1-14 judge, the district judges in Hunt County, and the judges [~~judge~~] of
1-15 the county courts [~~court~~] at law.

1-16 (b) The board shall designate a juvenile court judge to
1-17 serve as [~~is~~] the chairman of the board and its chief administrative
1-18 officer.

1-19 (d) Each judge on the board may [~~shall~~] appoint one citizen
1-20 to serve on the advisory council. Members of the advisory council
1-21 serve without compensation.

1-22 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
