A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT relating to the board of directors of the Kenedy County Groundwater 2 3 Conservation District. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. Chapter 1152, Acts of the 78th Legislature, 5 Regular Session, 2003, is amended by adding Section 9A to read as 6 follows: 7 8 Sec. 9A. METHOD OF ELECTING DIRECTORS: SINGLE-MEMBER DISTRICTS. (a) As soon as practicable after the effective date of 9 10 the Act by which this section is enacted into law, the board shall: (1) divide the district into five single-member 11 12 districts for electing directors; and 13 (2) assign each of the existing board positions to one of the new single-member districts. 14 15 (b) If the district annexes territory, the annexed territory becomes part of one or more of the single-member 16 17 districts as determined by the board. (c) One director shall be elected from each single-member 18 district. 19 (d) To be a candidate for or to serve as a director, a person 20 must be a registered voter in the single-member district the person 21 22 represents or seeks to represent. (e) A person shall indicate on the application for a place 23 24 on the ballot the single-member district the person seeks to

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1 represent. 2 (f) After each federal decennial census or as needed, the board may redraw the single-member districts to reflect population 3 changes. A director in office on the effective date of a change in 4 the boundaries of a single-member district, or a director elected 5 or appointed before the effective date of the change whose term of 6 7 office begins on or after the effective date of the change, shall serve for the remainder of the director's term in the single-member 8 district to which elected or appointed even though the change in 9 boundaries places the director's residence outside the district to 10 which the director was elected or appointed. 11 SECTION 2. Chapter 1162, Acts of the 78th Legislature, 12 13 Regular Session, 2003, is amended by adding Section 8A to read as follows: 14 15 Sec. 8A. METHOD OF ELECTING DIRECTORS: SINGLE-MEMBER 16 DISTRICTS. (a) As soon as practicable after the effective date of the Act by which this section is enacted into law, the board shall: 17 (1) divide the district into five single-member 18 districts for electing directors; and 19 20 (2) assign each of the existing board positions to one of the new single-member districts. 21 22 (b) If the district annexes territory, the annexed territory becomes part of one or more of the single-member 23 24 districts as determined by the board. 25 (c) One director shall be elected from each single-member 26 district. 27 (d) To be a candidate for or to serve as a director, a person

16	SECTION 3. The following laws are repealed:

21	SECTION 4. (a) The change in law made by this Act applies
22	only to a director elected or appointed to serve on the board of
23	directors of the Kenedy County Groundwater Conservation District on

(b) The change in law made by this Act does not affect the term of office of a director serving on the board of directors of the Kenedy County Groundwater Conservation District on the

24 or after the effective date of this Act.

2 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
