A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to annual reports by certain agencies conducting, funding, or supporting biomedical research. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Subtitle H, Title 2, Health and Safety Code, is amended by adding Chapter 172 to read as follows: 6 7 CHAPTER 172. BIOMEDICAL RESEARCH Sec. 172.001. DEFINITION. In this chapter, "state agency" 8 9 means a department, commission, board, office, or other agency in the executive branch of state government created by the state 10 constitution or a state statute, including an institution of higher 11 education as defined by Section 61.003, Education Code. 12 Sec. 172.002. ANNUAL REPORT. (a) Not later than December 1 13 14 of each year, a state agency that conducts, funds, or supports biomedical research shall submit to the governor, the Legislative 15 Budget Board, and the commissioner of state health services a 16 report, in the format established by the commissioner, on whether 17 the agency conducted, funded, or supported during the preceding 18 state fiscal year any research that involves stem cells or human 19 20 cloning. 21 (b) A state agency that conducts, funds, or supports any research that involves stem cells or human cloning must include in 22 23 the report submitted under Subsection (a) information on: (1) the type of research conducted, funded, or 24

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1 supported by the state agency that involves: 2 cells, including embryonic, (A) stem nonembryonic somatic, and induced pluripotent stem cells; and 3 4 (B) human cloning, including therapeutic and 5 reproductive cloning; 6 (2) the process through which the stem cells and stem 7 cell lines were derived, if applicable; 8 (3) the amount and source of state money used to 9 conduct, fund, or support the research; 10 (4) the use of state facilities to conduct or support the research; and 11 12 (5) the progress and results of the research. SECTION 2. Not later than December 1, 2009, a state agency 13 14 that conducts, funds, or supports biomedical research shall submit 15 the initial report required under Chapter 172, Health and Safety Code, as added by this Act. 16 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 17

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a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2009.

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
