A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment to increase the maximum amount
- 2 of the local option residence homestead exemption from ad valorem
- 3 taxation by a political subdivision from 20 percent to 30 percent.
- 4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 1-b(e), Article VIII, Texas 6 Constitution, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 (e) The governing body of a political subdivisi
- 7 (e) The governing body of a political subdivision[, other
- 8 than a county education district, may exempt from ad valorem
- 9 taxation a percentage of the market value of the residence
- 10 homestead of a married or unmarried adult, including one living
- 11 alone. [In the manner provided by law, the voters of a county
- 12 education district at an election held for that purpose may exempt
- 13 from ad valorem taxation a percentage of the market value of the
- 14 residence homestead of a married or unmarried adult, including one
- 15 <u>living alone.</u>] The percentage may not exceed <u>thirty</u> [twenty]
- 16 percent. However, the amount of an exemption authorized pursuant
- 17 to this subsection may not be less than Five Thousand Dollars
- 18 (\$5,000) unless the legislature by general law prescribes other
- 19 monetary restrictions on the amount of the exemption. An eligible
- 20 adult is entitled to receive other applicable exemptions provided
- 21 by law. Where ad valorem tax has previously been pledged for the
- 22 payment of debt, the governing body of a political subdivision may
- 23 continue to levy and collect the tax against the value of the
- 24 homesteads exempted under this subsection until the debt is

- 1 discharged if the cessation of the levy would impair the obligation
- 2 of the contract by which the debt was created. The legislature by
- 3 general law may prescribe procedures for the administration of
- 4 residence homestead exemptions.
- 5 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 6 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 3, 2009.
- 7 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 8 proposition: "The constitutional amendment to increase the maximum
- 9 amount of the local option residence homestead exemption from ad
- 10 valorem taxation by a political subdivision from 20 percent to 30
- 11 percent."
