A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment authorizing the legislature
- 2 to exempt from ad valorem taxation the residence homestead of the
- 3 surviving spouse of a 100 percent or totally disabled veteran in an
- 4 amount equal to the amount of the residence homestead exemption to
- 5 which the disabled veteran was entitled on the same property.
- 6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 7 SECTION 1. Section 1-b, Article VIII, Texas Constitution,
- 8 is amended by adding Subsection (j) to read as follows:
- 9 (j) The legislature by general law may provide that the
- 10 surviving spouse of a 100 percent or totally disabled veteran who
- 11 received an exemption under Subsection (i) of this section is
- 12 entitled to an exemption for the same property in an amount equal to
- 13 the amount of the exemption received by the disabled veteran if the
- 14 property:
- 15 (1) was the residence homestead of the surviving
- 16 spouse when the disabled veteran died; and
- 17 (2) remains the residence homestead of the surviving
- 18 spouse.
- 19 SECTION 2. The following temporary provision is added to
- 20 the Texas Constitution:
- 21 TEMPORARY PROVISION. (a) This temporary provision applies
- 22 to the constitutional amendment proposed by the 81st Legislature,
- 23 Regular Session, 2009, authorizing the legislature to exempt from
- 24 ad valorem taxation the residence homestead of the surviving spouse

- 1 of a 100 percent or totally disabled veteran in an amount equal to
- 2 the amount of the residence homestead exemption to which the
- 3 <u>disabled veteran was entitled.</u>
- 4 (b) Section 1-b(j), Article VIII, of this constitution
- 5 takes effect January 1, 2010, and applies only to a tax year
- 6 beginning on or after that date.
- 7 (c) This temporary provision expires January 1, 2011.
- 8 SECTION 3. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 9 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 3, 2009.
- 10 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 11 proposition: "The constitutional amendment authorizing the
- 12 legislature to exempt from ad valorem taxation the residence
- 13 homestead of the surviving spouse of a 100 percent or totally
- 14 disabled veteran in an amount equal to the amount of the residence
- 15 homestead exemption to which the disabled veteran was entitled on
- 16 the same property."
