1 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION

2 proposing a constitutional amendment relating to the right of

3 freedom of conscience.

4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 6, Article I, Texas Constitution, is

6 amended to read as follows:

7 Sec. 6. All men have a natural and indefeasible right to worship

8 Almighty God according to the dictates of their own consciences. No

9 man shall be compelled to attend, erect or support any place of

10 worship, or to maintain any ministry against his consent. No human

11 authority ought, in any case whatever, to control or interfere with

12 the rights of conscience in matters of religion, and no preference

13 shall ever be given by law to any religious society or mode of

14 worship. The right to act or refuse to act in a manner that is

15 substantially motivated by a sincerely held religious belief, may

16 not be substantially burdened unless the government proves it has a

17 compelling governmental interest in infringing on the specific act

18 or refusal to act and has used the least restrictive means in

19 furthering that interest. For the purposes of this section, a

20 burden includes indirect burdens such as withholding benefits,

21 assessing penalties, or an exclusion from programs or access to

22 <u>facilities</u>. The Legislature may make laws which presume that

23 ordinances, rules, orders, decisions, and practices that are

24 applied to persons in the custody of juvenile detention centers,

- 1 correctional facilities, prisons, jails or other penal
- 2 institutions to be in furtherance of a compelling governmental
- 3 interest and the least restrictive means of furthering that
- 4 <u>interest.</u> But it shall be the duty of the Legislature to pass such
- 5 laws as may be necessary to protect equally every religious
- 6 denomination in the peaceable enjoyment of its own mode of public
- 7 worship.
- 8 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 9 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 3, 2009.
- 10 The ballot shall be printed to provide for voting for or against the
- 11 proposition: "The constitutional amendment relating to the right
- 12 of freedom of conscience."
