1-13 Sec. 17. (a) All officers within this State, other than a member of the Texas Transportation Commission whose term has expired, shall continue to perform the duties of their offices until their successors shall be duly qualified. 1-14 1**-**15 1**-**16

(b) A member of the Texas Transportation Commission whose 1-17 term has expired may not continue to perform the duties of a member 1-18 1-19 of the commission, and a vacancy is created in the member's 1-20 1-21

position. SECTION 2.
