**WHEREAS**, A man of strength, passion, and courage in the face of adversity, Mr. Moreno gave generously to others, and his wisdom, his warmth, his sense of humor, and his love of spirited debate will not be forgotten by those who knew him; and

**WHEREAS**, He was a devoted husband, father, and grandfather, and his family and many friends will continue to live with the cherished memories of his life and many achievements; now, therefore, be it
