WHEREAS, A woman of dedication and compassion, she gave generously to others, and her wisdom, warmth, and zest for life will not be forgotten by those who knew her; and

WHEREAS, She was a devoted mother and grandmother, and she will continue to live in the hearts and minds of those she left behind; now, therefore, be it
