WHEREAS, As director of the National Memorial Cemetery of the Pacific, he is responsible for all burials and maintenance operations at the cemetery, which is located in Punchbowl Crater, the remnant of a long-extinct volcano; the cemetery is one of the State of Hawaii's most popular tourist attractions, and millions of people visit the site annually; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Senate of the State of Texas, 81st Legislature, hereby commend Gene E. Castagnetti on his outstanding military career and his work as director of the National Memorial Cemetery of the Pacific; and, be it further
