## Suspending limitations on conference committee jurisdiction, S.B. No. 379 (Carona/Guillen)

## RESOLUTION

- BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the State of Texas, 81st
- 2 Legislature, Regular Session, 2009, That Senate Rule 12.03 be
- 3 suspended in part as provided by Senate Rule 12.08 to enable the
- 4 conference committee appointed to resolve the differences on Senate
- 5 Bill 379, relating to an annual report by the Texas Fusion Center
- 6 regarding criminal street gangs and gang-related crime, to consider
- 7 and take action on the following matter:
- 8 (1) Senate Rule 12.03(1) is suspended to permit the
- 9 committee to change text not in disagreement in proposed SECTION 1
- 10 of the bill, in added Section 421.082(e), Government Code, and in
- 11 SECTION 2 of the bill, so that they read as follows:
- 12 (e) The gang section of the center shall annually submit to
- 13 the governor and the legislature a report assessing the threat
- 14 posed statewide by criminal street gangs. The report must include
- 15 identification of:
- 16 (1) law enforcement strategies that have been proven
- 17 effective in deterring gang-related crime; and
- 18 (2) gang involvement in trafficking of persons.
- 19 SECTION 2. The gang section of the Texas Fusion Center shall
- 20 submit the first annual report required by Subsection (e), Section
- 21 421.082, Government Code, as added by this Act, not later than
- 22 September 1, 2010.
- 23 Explanation: This change is necessary to require the gang
- 24 section of the Texas Fusion Center to produce the report and to

- 1 ensure that certain matters are included in the report.
- 2 (2) Senate Rule 12.03(1) is suspended to permit the
- 3 committee to change text not in disagreement in proposed SECTION 1
- 4 of the bill, in added Section 421.082(f), Government Code, so that
- 5 it reads as follows:
- 6 (f) On request, the office of the attorney general, the
- 7 Department of Public Safety, the Texas Department of Criminal
- 8 Justice, other law enforcement agencies, and juvenile justice
- 9 agencies of this state shall provide to the gang section of the
- 10 center information relating to criminal street gangs, gang-related
- 11 crime, and gang involvement in trafficking of persons.
- 12 Explanation: This change is necessary to require certain law
- 13 enforcement agencies to comply with a request from the Texas Fusion
- 14 Center to provide information relating to criminal street gangs,
- 15 gang-related crime, and gang involvement in trafficking of persons.
- 16 (3) Senate Rule 12.03(2) is suspended to permit the
- 17 committee to omit text not in disagreement in proposed SECTION 1 of
- 18 the bill, by omitting added Section 421.082(g), Government Code.
- 19 Explanation: The omission is necessary to remove a
- 20 restriction on the information that may be included in the report.
