**IN RE: HB11** by Leibowitz (Relating to repeal of authority for the establishment and operation of the Trans-Texas Corridor.), **As Introduced**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Transportation Code to repeal provisions pertaining to the establishment, development, operation, financing, and acquisition of right-of-way for the Trans-Texas Corridor.

Based on the analysis of the Texas Department of Transportation, it is assumed any costs or duties associated with the enactment of the bill could be absorbed within the agency's existing resources.

**Local Government Impact**

No fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
