IN RE: HB258 by Berman (Relating to the date on which a declaration of write-in candidacy must be filed.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would change the dates required by write-in candidates to file for candidacy.

The bill would repeal Sections 11.056(e) and 130.0825(e) of the Education Code, Section 285.131(g) of the Health and Safety Code, and Section 63.0945(f) of the Water Code, all relating to filing deadlines for candidates.

Local Government Impact

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
