### No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would allow a person to use a federal postcard application as a means to vote in an election. The bill would take effect September 1, 2009.

## **Local Government Impact**

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated. The bill would allow an unregistered voter that meets the application requirements under Title 2 of the Election Code to submit a federal postcard application to vote in an election.
