IN RE: HB756 by Martinez Fischer (Relating to the making or acceptance of political contributions in a building owned by or leased to the state.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Election Code related to making a political contribution in a building owned or leased by the state. It is assumed that any additional cost associated with the implementation of the bill could be absorbed within existing state resources.

Local Government Impact

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
