**IN RE: HB756** by Martinez Fischer (Relating to the making or acceptance of political contributions in a building owned by or leased to the state.), **As Introduced**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Election Code related to making a political contribution in a building owned or leased by the state. It is assumed that any additional cost associated with the implementation of the bill could be absorbed within existing state resources.
