**IN RE: HB1198** by Button (Relating to the qualifications for certification of a person as a qualified business under the enterprise zone program. ), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill defines high technology and limits the ability of high technology businesses to use enterprise zone residents to reach certain hiring requirements for the Texas Enterprise Zone Program.
