IN RE: HB1573 by Thompson (Relating to a requirement that a recipient of money from the Texas Enterprise Fund provide a health benefit plan for its employees.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would require grant recipients of the Texas Enterprise Fund to provide a health benefit plan to its employees used in any activity or project financed by the grant. The bill would be effective September 1, 2009.
