**IN RE: HB1739** by Howard, Donna (Relating to a recognition day to celebrate Texas native plants.),  
**As Introduced**

The bill would designate October 15 as Texas Native Plant Day in the state.

The bill would take effect immediately upon receiving a two-thirds majority vote in both houses; otherwise, the bill would take effect September 1, 2009.
