**IN RE: HB1832** by Corte (Relating to the issuance of French Legion of Honor specialty license plates.), **As Introduced**

<b>No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.</b>

The bill would amend the Transportation Code to require the Texas Department of Transportation to issue "Legion of Honor" specialty license plates to a recipient of the French Legion of Honor.

Based on the analysis of the Texas Department of Transportation, it is assumed any costs or duties associated implementing the provisions of the bill could be absorbed within existing resources. Also based on the analysis of TxDOT, it is assumed the issuance of the new Legion of Honor specialty plates would not result in a significant impact to state revenues.

**Local Government Impact**

No fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
