IN RE: HB1874 by Truitt (Relating to regulation of the practice of barbering.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would require the Department of Licensing and Regulation to amend rules for the issuance of a barbershop permit. The Department of Licensing and Regulation anticipates it could implement the provisions of this bill using existing agency resources.
