IN RE: HB1913 by McReynolds (Relating to identification requirements for certain fire hydrants and flush valves.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Health and Safety Code to require public water systems responsible for any hydrant to paint the hydrant or the hydrant cap using a color coding system for identifying the hydrant's use. Not later than January 1, 2010, each public water system responsible for hydrants would be required to ensure that its hydrants comply with Section 341.0357, Health and Safety Code, as amended by the bill.

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
