IN RE: HB1968 by Hartnett (Relating to the estates of decedents.), **As Introduced**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Texas Probate Code to authorize a court to take certain actions, as listed in the bill, to remedy a breach of fiduciary duty by a personal representative.
