**IN RE: HB2118** by Olivo (Relating to the designation of May 9 as Willie Velasquez Day.), **As Introduced**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would add "Willie Velasquez Day" as an optional holiday for state employees on May 9<sup>th</sup> of each year. An agency head could allow an employee to have May 9th off with pay in lieu of another state holiday that the employee would take off during the same fiscal year.
