**IN RE: HB2260** by Truitt (Relating to adoption of the Uniform Adult Guardianship and Protective Proceedings Jurisdiction Act.), **As Introduced**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill adopts the Uniform Adult Guardianship and Protective Proceedings Jurisdiction Act. It provides the exclusive jurisdictional basis for a Texas court to appoint a guardian for an adult and addresses determination of jurisdiction as between Texas courts and the courts of other states.
