IN RE: HB2724 by Woolley (Relating to persons authorized to conduct a marriage ceremony.), **As Introduced**

The bill would amend the Family Code relating to persons authorized to conduct a marriage ceremony. The bill would add a federal administrative law judge to those persons authorized to conduct a marriage ceremony. The bill would take effect September 1, 2009.
