IN RE: HB2822 by Flores (Relating to requiring a regional mobility authority to post on its website copies of minutes approved at a meeting.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Government Code to require a regional mobility authority (RMA) created under Chapter 370, Transportation Code, to post on the RMA's Internet website within three working days the minutes or summaries of the minutes approved at a meeting of the board of directors.
