**IN RE: HB2870** by King, Phil (Relating to the requirement that certain state and local governmental entities designate a firearms proficiency officer and require weapons proficiency.), **As Introduced**

<b>No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.</b>

The bill would amend the Occupations Code to require agencies that employ one or more peace officers to designate a firearms proficiency officer, and require all officers demonstrate firearms proficiency annually. It has been determined that costs associated with implementing the bill would not be significant to the affected agencies.
