IN RE: HB2989 by Phillips (Relating to the reactivation of a peace officer license for certain peace officers.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Occupations Code, Section 1701.3161 to allow the Texas Commission on Law Enforcement Officer Standards and Education (TCLEOSE) to reinstate the license of a person previously licensed as a peace officer if the person holds an advanced proficiency certificate. The bill would also allow TCLEOSE to waive the reinstatement fee for persons applicable to the bill. The bill would also prevent TCLEOSE from reinstating a peace officer's license for a person applicable to the bill if the person's peace officer license was previously revoked. The bill would take effect September 1, 2009. TCLEOSE anticipates no significant fiscal impact to their agency.

Local Government Impact

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
