**IN RE: HB3091** by Veasey (Relating to proof that is acceptable for identifying individuals acknowledging written instruments.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Civil Practice and Remedies Code requiring an officer to accept a current document issued by a foreign government as satisfactory evidence of the identity of a person. The bill would take effect September 1, 2009.
