**IN RE: HB3315** by Gonzales (Relating to the employment and powers of, and procedures for matters referred to, a statutory probate court associate judge.), **As Introduced**

The bill would amend the Government Code affecting probate court procedures, including powers of a statutory probate court associate judge and requiring the use of a court reporter when an associate judge presides over a jury trial.
