**IN RE: HB3331** by Pierson (Relating to local option alcoholic beverage elections in justice precincts.), **As Introduced**

**No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Alcoholic Beverage Code to make various adjustments and additions to requirements related to a local option alcoholic beverage election, including requiring that a local option election held in a justice precinct be held in the territory comprising the justice precinct at the time the election is held. Under current statute, that requirement is optional.

**Local Government Impact**

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
