**IN RE: HB3350** by Hartnett (Relating to decedents' estates.), **As Introduced**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill clarifies venue in certain causes of action involving decedents' estates and provides an alternative method of making a will self-proving. The bill also clarifies when dissolution of a marriage revokes certain nontestamentary transfers.

**Local Government Impact**

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
