**IN RE: HB3443** by Anchia (Relating to tenant's remedies regarding governmental determination of substandard housing.), **As Introduced**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Property Code and provides a tenant certain rights if a municipality or county revokes a certificate of occupancy for leased premises. It is assumed that any costs associated with implementation of the bill would not be significant.
