**IN RE: HB3671** by Sheffield (Relating to the documents that are required for the transfer of a defendant from a county to the Texas Department of Criminal Justice.), **As Engrossed**

The bill would amend the Code of Criminal Procedure to remove the requirement to include a copy of the record of arrest for each offense in the documents that must be provided when transferring a defendant from a county to the Texas Department of Criminal Justice.

**Local Government Impact**

Counties would experience a slight savings in administrative costs associated with the current requirement to include copies of arrest records.

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
