IN RE: HB3741 by Eissler (Relating to physical education curriculum and instruction in public schools.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The Texas Education Agency estimates that the bill's requirement to update the physical education curriculum could be accomplished with existing resources.

Local Government Impact

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.

Costs for school districts, in implementing the bill's requirements to maintain a properly certified physical education instructor and to update the physical education curriculum, could vary.
