IN RE: HB3771 by Farias (Relating to authorization for school districts to provide mentors for teachers assigned to a new subject or grade level.), **As Introduced**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would specify that school districts may assign a mentor to teachers with less than two years of experience in the subject or grade level to which the teacher is assigned.
