IN RE: SB669 by Shapleigh (Relating to the availability of online testing for high school equivalency examinations.), **As Engrossed**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would require the State Board of Education to adopt rules to provide for online administration of high school equivalency examinations, including a procedure for verifying the identity of the examinee, if the national entity that develops and delivers such examinations authorizes online testing.
