IN RE: SB1059 by Hegar (Relating to the procedure for the removal of a cattle guard on a county road.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Transportation Code to authorize a county commissioners court to remove a cattle guard if the commissioners court notifies each person who owns land adjacent to the cattle guard by certified mail not less than 90 days before the proposed removal. A public hearing would not be required unless an affected resident submits, before the 75th day after the date the notice is mailed by the commissioners court, a written request for a hearing.

Local Government Impact

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
