**IN RE: SB1122** by Hegar (Relating to the requirement to keep records of game bird or animal carcasses placed in a cold storage or processing facility.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

**No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Parks and Wildlife Code relating to the requirement to keep records of game bird or animal carcasses placed in a cold storage or processing facility. The bill would redefine the anatomical parameters of "quartering" an animal; effective September 1, 2009. The Texas Parks and Wildlife Department indicates there is no fiscal implication to implementing the provisions of the bill.

**Local Government Impact**

No fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
